



HKSF Sustainability Principles

1. Identify, manage and work to minimize our environmental and climate change impacts and integrate sustainability considerations into decision-making processes at all levels of HKSF's operations and management.
2. Work with our partners and other stakeholders, including contractors, suppliers and vendors, to minimize environmental and climate change impacts and encourage them to act in a more sustainable manner.
3. Organise and manage sailing events, including sail training, in accordance with recognized best practices aimed at reducing impacts on the marine environment and restoring ocean health, including, for example, the Sailors for the Sea Clean Regatta programme.
4. Educate and engage our members and staff on environmental and sustainability issues and encourage them to minimize their impacts on the environment in their daily lives.
5. Establish data collection systems to enable us to monitor, report and manage our environmental impacts and set appropriate targets, objectives, and metrics for their reduction and where possible avoidance.
6. Actively encourage and support, in all forms, the application of new approaches and technologies that are aimed to reduce environmental impacts, improve sustainability and optimize the management and value of the Association.
7. Communicate and share best practices with the sailing clubs and associations and water sports organisations to promote education and awareness, reduce environmental impacts of watersports, and help bring about positive change.
8. Establish governance systems, such as Sustainability Ambassadors, necessary to implement this Policy and achieve its objectives.
