



HONG KONG SAILING FEDERATION (“HKSF”) Bad Weather Arrangement Recommendations

1. PREAMBLE

The following Bad Weather Arrangement Recommendations are applicable to all open water sailing activities. These activities include leisure sailing; on water training; and racing organised or co-organised by HKSF; sailing clubs; sailing associations, water sports centres, sail training centres; and individuals.

These Recommendations are not guidelines, nor mandatory to the abovementioned organisations and individuals who may opt to have their own arrangement in Bad Weather conditions at their own risk and liability.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Black Rainstorm Signal/Typhoon Signal No. 3 or above

- All on-water sailing activities should be postponed or cancelled.

2.2 Typhoon Signal No. 1/Strong Monsoon Signal

- At the judgement of the organizing authority or individuals to postpone or cancel the activity, based on Hong Kong Observatory’s report and forecast and insurance arrangement.

2.3 Thunderstorm Warning/Amber or Red Rainstorm Warning Signal

- At the judgement of the organizing authority or individuals to postpone or cancel the activity, based on Hong Kong Observatory’s report and forecast and insurance arrangement.
