



# HKSF Pre-Entry Assessment

Organised By: Hong Kong Sailing Federation

People who are interested in taking a HKSF Dinghy Instructor Course or convert their overseas Dinghy Instructor qualification by taking a HKSF Dinghy Instructor Validation Course must attend and pass a one-day Pre-Entry Assessment. The Assessment is intended to confirm that the candidate has the sailing ability and background knowledge required of an HKSF Dinghy Instructor. For details of the assessment, please refer to the HKSF Syllabus and Logbook for Dinghy Instructors Scheme published in 2008.

**Date:** 25 September 2021 Time: 0900-1700  
26 September 2021 Time: 0900-1700 (Backup Date only)

Note: if the conditions are not suitable then the backup date will be used.

**Venue:** Hong Kong Sailing Federation Little Palm Beach Sailing Centre (or another venue)

## Eligibility:

1. Aged 18 or above; and
2. Candidates must hold a valid **First Aid Certificate** and a valid **Master and Engineering License** issued by Marine Department; and
3. Candidates for the Pre-Entry Assessment must be holders of HKSF Level 4, Day Sailing Certificates and Racing Skills Certificates in the new scheme which came into force on 1 April 2006; or
4. Candidates must hold a valid Dinghy Instructor or Senior Instructor certificate issued by other Member National Authority of World Sailing.

**Language for Teaching:** English / Cantonese

**Deadline for Enrolment:** 8 September 2021

**Optimal Capacity:** 8 persons (HKSF reserves the right to increase the capacity)

**Fee:** Course Fee \$1,500/person for HKSF member, \$1,800/person for non-member

**Enrolment Method:** Complete the Enrolment Form and submit Copies of the Teaching Log and the certificates as mentioned in the Eligibility to the **HKSF Office at Room 1009, Olympic House, 1 Stadium Path, So Kon Po, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong**. A cheque for payment of Pre-Entry Assessment Fee made payable to "Hong Kong Sailing Federation" should also be enclosed with the Enrolment Form.

**Enrollment applications completed with relevant certificates and payment will be accepted on a first come first served basis.**
